PURPOSE: To receive public comments and to consider adoption of (1) a proposed Ordinance deleting from the San Rafael Municipal Code Chapter 11.04 entitled "Sidewalks, Driveway Approaches, Curbs, and Gutters", Chapter 11.06 entitled "Use of Public-Right-of-Way", and Chapter 11.08 entitled "Excavations in Streets and Other Public Places", and adding new Chapter 11.04 to the San Rafael Municipal Code entitled "Encroachments in the Public Right-of-Way, and (2) a related Resolution adopting specifications and requirements for the design, installation and maintenance of encroachments in the Public Right-of-Way.
