**PURPOSE:** To receive public comments and to consider adoption of a proposed ordinance amending Chapter 12.12 of the San Rafael Municipal Code to delegate to the Building Official the enforcement of fire and panic safety regulations in the California Building Code and regulations adopted by the State Fire Marshal, and amending Chapter 4.04 and 4.08 of the San Rafael Municipal Code to shift certain duties of the Fire Prevention Bureau, Fire Marshal, Fire Chief and Fire Department to the Building Official in connection with Phase II of the Fire Department Reorganization.
