PURPOSE: To receive public comments and to consider adoption of a proposed ordinance amending the San Rafael Municipal Code, including Sections 1.08.020, 8.20.080, 9.30.030, 10.40.200, 15.06.050, 15.06.120, 15.11.100, and 15.12.080, to revise previous references to fire marshal, deputy fire marshal, and fire prevention bureau, to be consistent with the recent amendments of SRMC Chapter 4.08 transferring fire prevention functions to the chief building official in connection with the Fire Department Phase II Reorganization.
