CERT BASIC

Through San Rafael’s CERT Basic course you will learn how to manage utilities and put out small fires; treat the “three killers” by opening airways, controlling bleeding, and treating for shock; provide basic medical aid; search for and rescue victims safely; and organize yourself and spontaneous volunteers to be effective.

All CERT Basic classes are held in San Rafael. Classes will run from 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. each night and will be held both indoors and outdoors. Participants should plan to attend all classes. Classes are structured as both classroom lecture and hands-on activities. There will be many physical exercises in this class in the areas of: fire suppression, light search and rescue, victim extrication, carrying techniques, heavy lifting of objects, and disaster medical operations.



Cost = \$40

Registration fee includes a student manual, helmet, vest and protective eye wear. Students will need to supply their own gloves. *Optional purchase: \$60 CERT response kit including utilities wrench, heavy duty flashlight, first aid kit, face mask, whistle, heavy duty gloves, protective eye wear, light sticks, duct tape, and emergency blanket.
