

Ordinance Enforcement Procedures

Information about “Notice and Orders” and other Legal Proceedings

It is always our intention to educate first and penalize last. This is why we provide a great deal of time in meeting with the public about the new Vegetation Management Program and the concepts of 100 feet of Defensible Space.

There will be times that citizens, for many different reasons, have not worked with us and desire not to create a Defensible Space to protect themselves and other citizens at the time of a wildland fire. We have the following enforcement procedures in place to address those situations:

When a Notice and Order is ignored, the recipient must then appear before an Administrative Hearing Judge, Here is an example of that form:
